- Continuing each city's disaster training exchanges and programs, and enhancement of human resource capabilities



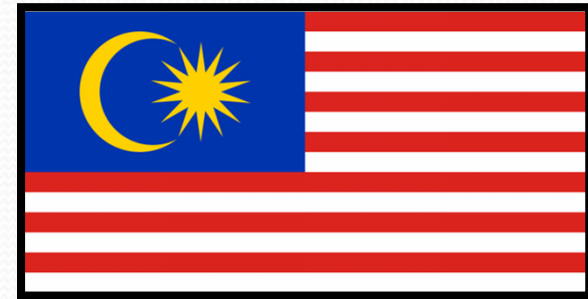
