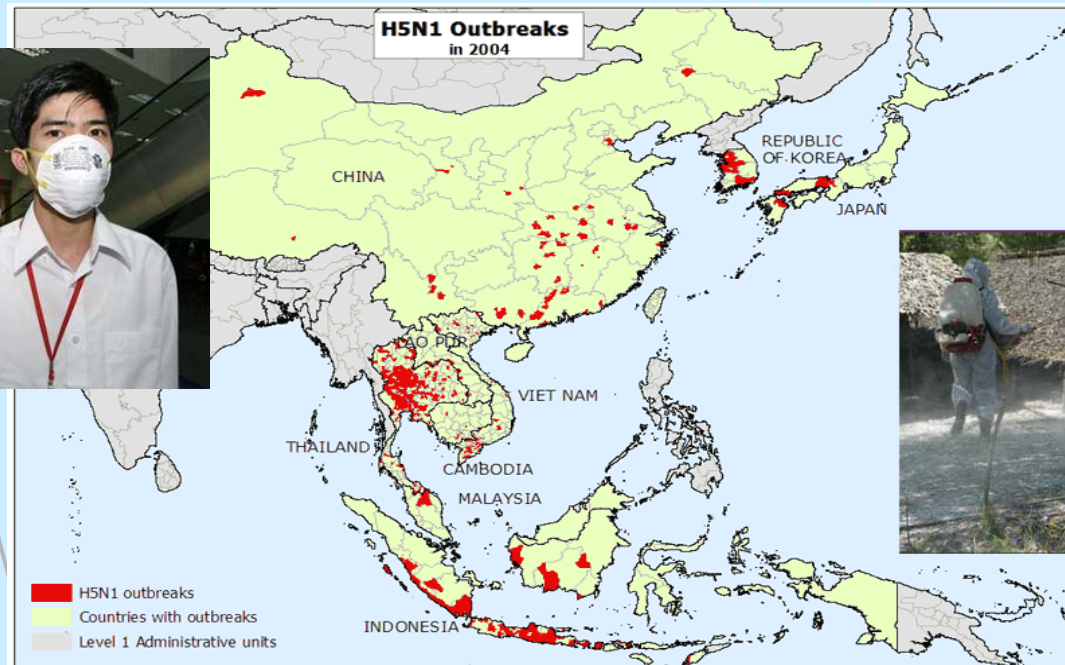


# Countermeasures to Combat Infectious Diseases in Asia

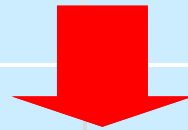

Cities cooperate to work on measures against infectious diseases


(Agreed in 2004, 11 cities participate.)
