

Outbreak of SARS & avian influenza seriously affected major Asian cities




Cities cooperate to work on measures against infectious diseases (Agreed in 2004, 11 cities participate. Participating cities: Bangkok, Delhi, Hanoi, Jakarta, Kuala Lumpur, Manila, Seoul, Singapore, Taipei, Tokyo, Yangon)



Activities

- 1. Building the network (medical doctors, researchers, etc.)
- Conference on Countermeasures to Combat Infectious Diseases in Asia (annually)
- Infectious Diseases Information Network System (K-net)
- Exchange of information in case of an outbreak of infectious disease, etc.





Project Contents

2. Joint Research and Survey
Joint Research and Survey on routes of infection, medical treatments, preventive measures, etc.

Subjects

- 1. Tuberculosis (2009 to 2011)
- 2. Pandemic influenza (2012 to 2014)
- 3. HIV/AIDS
