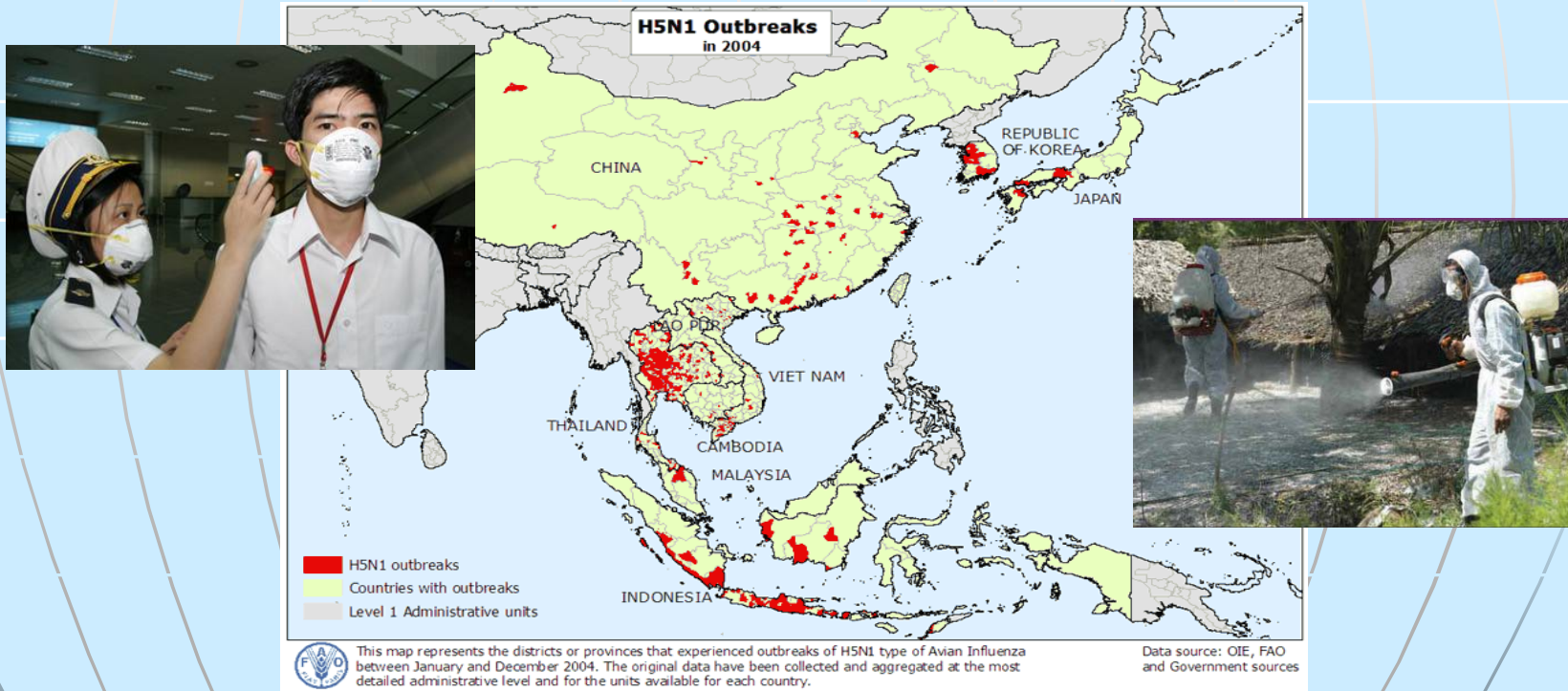
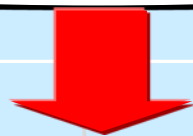


Countermeasures to Combat Infectious Diseases in Asia

Activities

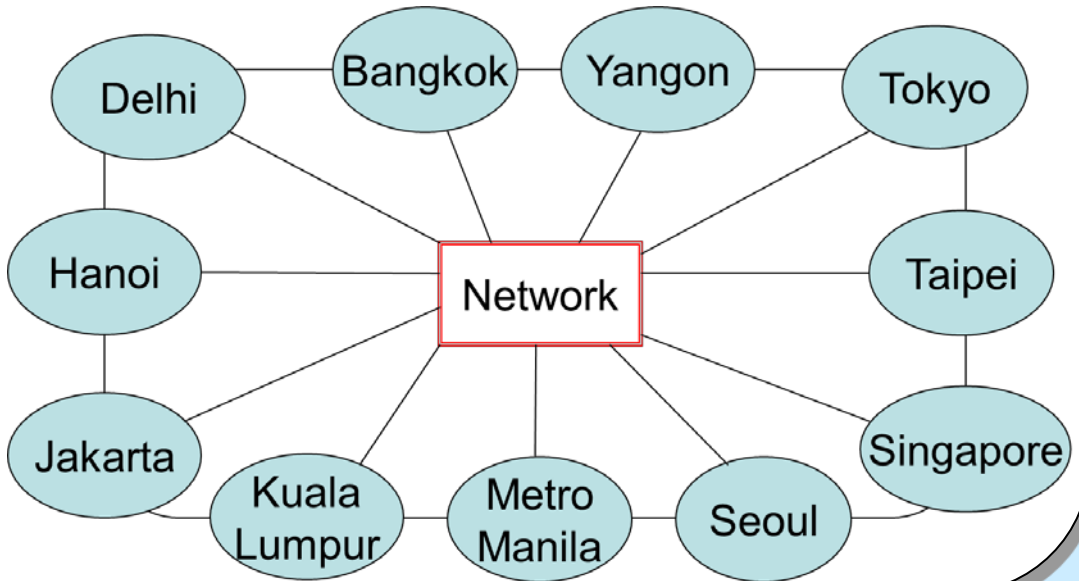
1. Building the network

 - Topics are TB, HIV/AIDS, Influenza, Dengue, etc.
 - The 10th conference (Feb. 3-5, 2015, Bangkok)
- ◆ Infectious Diseases Information Network System (K-net, since 2006)
