




# **Industry Promotion and Job Creation**

# **Branding and Promoting Local Products**

Tokyo is steadily strengthening the production infrastructure for agriculture, forestry, and fishery products, such as maintaining and expanding the production system for Tokyo brand meat products, and is adding value to these products and strengthening their selling power. By making full use of the high-profile event, the Tokyo 2020 Games, the attractiveness of Tokyo's agriculture, forestry, and fishery products is now gaining recognition both domestically and abroad.

A range of attractions to meet the various needs of tourists have been created by supporting the local communities of the Tama area and Tokyo islands in their efforts to develop their distinguishing features such as the landscape, tradition, culture, food, and nature into tourism resources.

### ► City planning tailored to area needs Approach 24

In the Tama area, housing and transportation infrastructure supporting daily life will be tailored to the character of each area to raise convenience and secure routes for evacuation and the transport of goods in the event of disaster. In the islands, disaster preparedness will be enhanced by advancing measures targeting earthquake, tsunami, and sediment disasters.

### ► Conveying the charms of the area

While protecting Tokyo's world-renowned natural environments, including Mt. Takao and the Ogasawara Islands, the attractions of the Tama area and Tokyo's islands will be widely conveyed, bringing many visitors from across Japan and abroad.

The rich natural environment will be passed on to future generations by encouraging Tokyo residents to experience nature first hand and promoting measures to protect rare species in nature conservation areas.
